

Professional Licensure and Certification Requirements: Respiratory Therapy Programs

Certain programs offered by Universidad Ana G. Mendez Cupey Campus are designed to meet educational requirements for a professional license or certification that is required by state law for a graduate of the program to obtain employment in a specific occupation. The following disclosures contain information about the states in which our relevant programs are designed to meet the educational requirements for a specific license or certification.

Requirements for professional licensure and certification vary from state to state, and prospective students are responsible for understanding the requirements in the state in which they plan to work after graduation. UAGM does not guarantee that a student will obtain licensure, certification or employment. Please note that the following information relates only to the educational requirements for the licenses and certifications listed below and is specific to the institution/campus listed above. Other requirements and prerequisites may apply to these licenses and certifications, such as requirements that an applicant successfully completes a criminal or other background check.

The **Associate Degree in Respiratory Therapy** offered at UAGM Cupey Campus and UAGM Bayamón is designed to meet the educational requirements to apply the two exams required by the Puerto Rico Board of Examiners of Respiratory Therapy Technicians.

The **Bachelor Degree in Natural Sciences major in Respiratory Therapy** at UAGM Cupey Campus is designed to meet the educational requirements to apply the two exams required by the Puerto Rico Board of Examiners of Respiratory Therapy Technicians.

The institution has determined that these curriculums *meets* the educational requirements for state licensure required for employment as a Respiratory Therapist, depending on the program completed, in Puerto Rico.
