

PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE AND CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS Teacher Preparation Programs

Several programs offered at Universidad Ana G. Mendez – Gurabo Campus are designed to meet the educational requirements to obtain a professional license or certification, mandatory by state law in order for a university graduate to be employed in a specific occupation. The following disclosure contains information about the US jurisdictions for which the program in reference is designed to meet the educational requirements for a specific license or certification.

Requirements for professional licensure and certification vary from state to state, and prospective students are responsible for understanding the requirements in the state in which they plan to work after graduation. UAGM does not guarantee that a student will obtain licensure, certification or employment. Please note that the following information relates only to the educational requirements for the licenses and certifications listed below and is specific to the institution/campus stated above. Other requirements and prerequisites may apply to these licenses and certifications, such as that an applicant successfully complete a criminal record check or other background screenings.

The **Teacher Preparation Programs** offered at UAGM Gurabo Campus and/or its locations, is designed to meet the educational requirements to apply for the *Prueba de Certificación de Maestros* (Teacher Certification Exam, PCMAS for its Spanish acronym) required to obtain the **teacher certification** issued by the *Departamento de Educación de Puerto Rico* (Puerto Rico Department of Education).

The institution has determined that the following teacher preparation curriculums *meet* the educational requirements to apply for the board exam and obtain state certification required for employment as a **teacher** in Puerto Rico:

- O Bachelor of Education with concentration in Level Fourth to Sixth
- **O** Bachelor of Education with concentration in Primary Level
- **O** Bachelor of Education with concentration in Preschool Level
- **O** Bachelor of Elementary Education with concentration in English
- O Bachelor of Special Education concentration in Special Education K-12
- O Bachelor of Physical Education concentration in Level K-12
- **O** Bachelor of Secondary Education concentration in Biology
- **O** Bachelor of Secondary Education concentration in General Science
- O Bachelor of Secondary Education concentration in Social Science
- O Bachelor of Secondary Education concentration in Vocational Industrial Education
- O Bachelor of Secondary Education concentration in Spanish
- **O** Bachelor of Secondary Education concentration in History
- **O** Bachelor of Secondary Education concentration in English

- **O** Bachelor of Secondary Education concentration in Mathematics
- O Bachelor of Secondary Education concentration in Chemistry
