

AGGRESSIVE ANIMAL POLICY

Given the nature of the Program of Veterinary Technology and the exposure of students, professors, and other program personnel, we must ensure their safety. It is in the best interest for student's learning experiences that hands-on activities take place. We must carefully select the animals that will be used for these purposes. The Program of Veterinary Technology from Universidad Ana G. Méndez *will not allow* aggressive animals to be used in any activity. In the event of an aggressive animal being identified or that could be dangerous for students, professors, or program personnel, it will be immediately disqualified for use in any demonstration.

The program will provide professors with muzzles and restriction devices for demonstration purposes. If it is the case, professors and student will have access to these devices to ensure their safety during any activity.

Activities involving animals *must* be supervised by the course professors at every moment.
